



CONSORTIUM AGREEMENT

for the implementation of the project for the promotion and development of dual learning regarding the application for the grant scheme funded by LuxDev in collaboration with KIESA

I. Signatory Parties

This cooperation agreement is concluded between:

[Name of the Public Vocational School - _____], headquartered at [Address - _____], represented by [Name, Surname, Position - _____], hereinafter referred to as **“School”**; and

2. [Private Business Name - _____], headquartered at [Address - _____], with business number [no- _____], represented by [Name, Surname, Position - _____], hereinafter referred to as **“Business”**.

Both parties together shall hereinafter be referred to as the “Consortium” - _____”

II. Purpose of the agreement

The purpose of this agreement is to establish cooperation between the School and private business for the implementation of the dual learning program, which enables the development of the practical part of vocational education in business environments, in harmony with the relevant vocational education curriculum.

III. Areas of cooperation

The Parties agree to cooperate in the following areas:

1. Development of professional practice for School students in Business environments;
2. Harmonization of the curriculum with the needs of the labour market and modern technology;
3. Professional counselling and practical training by Business experts;
4. Promotion of dual learning and encouragement of employment of qualified young people;
5. Ensuring appropriate conditions for practical learning (tools, equipment, safety and hygiene at work).

IV. School Obligations

The school is obliged to:

- Select students who will participate in the internship according to agreed criteria;

- Provide pedagogical supervision and coordination with Business mentors;
- Harmonize the internship schedule with the curriculum;
- Monitor the progress and assessment of students in collaboration with Business.

V. Business Obligations

Business is obliged to:

- Provide adequate conditions for the development of professional practice;
- Assign qualified mentors to supervise students;
- Recognize practical work hours as part of the curriculum;
- Provide the necessary equipment, materials and instructions for the development of practice;
- Respect the standards of safety and protection at work for student interns;
- Provide an assessment of the performance of students at the end of the practice.

VI. Joint obligations

"Student insurance" in the dual education system in Kosovo is regulated based on the legislation in force. The signatory parties to this agreement are obliged to provide student insurance and this issue is the subject of the agreement between the parties.

VII. Duration of the agreement

This agreement shall enter into force on the date of signature and shall be valid for the period [_____], with the possibility of renewal with the consent of both parties.

VII. Monitoring and evaluation

The implementation of the agreement will be monitored by a joint committee, composed of representatives of the School and Business, which will report on the progress of the project and propose improvements.

VIII. Dispute resolution

Any dispute arising from the implementation of this agreement will be resolved amicably between the parties. In case of impossibility of reaching an agreement, the matter will be referred for resolution to the competent legal authorities of the Republic of Kosovo.

IX. Signature

This agreement was drawn up in two (2) original copies, one for each party, and enters into force on the date of signature.
