Pursuant to article 93 - paragraph 4; article 119 - paragraph 1; article 145 - paragraph 2 of the Constitution of the Republic of Kosovo, article 4.21 of the Law No.03/L-189 on State Administration of the Republic of Kosovo; article 8 - paragraph 1, sub-paragraph 1.4 and Annex 8 of Regulation No. 02/2011 on Areas of Administrative Responsibility of Prime Minister's Office and Kosovo Ministries, the Minister of Trade and Industry takes the following:

DECISION
ON PRINCIPLES REGARDING RECIPROCAL TRADE RELATIONS

1. The principle on reciprocal trade relations is taken toward the Republic of Serbia and the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina, as follows:
 - 1.1 Customs stamps and tax administration stamps of the Republic of Serbia are not recognized. All the goods accompanied by documentation containing the cited stamps are banned from entering Kosovo.
 - 1.2 Customs stamps of the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina are not recognized. Customs duty of 10% shall apply to all the goods accompanied by documentation containing these stamps.
2. The Kosovo Customs is required to apply the measures as defined in section 1 of this Decision.
3. The Decision comes into force on the day of its signature.
