Pursuant to Article 9, Articles 10 (paragraph 1 and 2) and article 11 of Law No. 06/L-113 on the Organization and Functioning of the State Administration and Independent Agencies, Articles 11(paragraph 1. subparagraph 1.5), and 12 of Law No. 08/L-117 on the Government of the Republic of Kosovo, Article 15 of Law No. 08/L-018 on Trade with Petroleum Products and Renewable Fuels, Article 4 paragraph 1. subparagraph 1.1 and subparagraph 1.2, Article 7 of Administrative Instruction (GRK) No. 03/2022 on Price Regulation of Petroleum Products and Renewable Fuels and Other Protective Measures, Article 1 of Administrative Instruction (QRK) No. 09/2022 on Supplementing and Amending Administrative Instruction (QRK) No. 03/2022 on Price Regulation of Petroleum Products and Renewable Fuels and Other Protective Measures, Annex 12 of Regulation (GRK) No. 04/2023 on Areas of Administrative Responsibility of the Office of the Prime Minister and Ministries, the Acting Deputy Minister of Industry, Entrepreneurship and Trade issues the following:

D E C I S I O N

1. The following price regulation and other protective measures are set for petroleum products used in transportation:
 - 1.1. The maximum allowed wholesale trade margin is two (2) eurocents per litre;
 - 1.2. The maximum allowed retail trade margin is twelve (12) eurocents per litre;
 - 1.3. Entities are required to supply and offer petroleum products for sale, as before the establishment of prices and protective measures;
 - 1.4. Increased inspection supervision;
 - 1.5. Expedited submission of the case to the Competition Authority, when there are suspicions of infringement of free competition.
2. The price regulation and measures referred to in Article 1 of this Decision shall remain in force for ninety (90) days from the date of entry into force of this Decision.
3. The supervision of the implementation of this decision shall be carried out by the Market Inspectorate in cooperation with the Customs and Tax Administration.

R e a s o n i n g

The Ministry of Industry, Entrepreneurship and Trade has regularly monitored the oil product markets, and the daily evidence received from Kosovo Customs regarding the supply/import prices of oil products as well as the daily reports from the Market Inspectorate regarding the wholesale and retail prices of oil products, suggest that frequent price movements in the international market are reflected in our domestic market mainly when there is an increase in prices but not in cases where there is a decrease. Therefore, the disproportionality between declared oil prices in imports and the prices in our domestic market constitutes grounds for price regulation and the imposition of other protective measures under Article 15, paragraph 2, subparagraph 2.3 of Law No. 08/L-018 on Trade with Petroleum Products and Renewable Fuels, Article 3, paragraph 2, subparagraph 2.3 of Administrative Instruction (GRK) No. 03/2022 on Price Regulation of Petroleum Products and Renewable Fuels and Other Protective Measures.

Price regulation and other protective measures are determined based on Article 4 and Article 6 of Administrative Instruction (GRK) No. 03/2022 on Price Regulation of Petroleum Products and Renewable Fuels and Other Protective Measures and aims to protect consumers, protect competition and eliminate market distortions.

The calculation of the maximum trade margin allowed for wholesale and retail sales is made according to Article 4, paragraph 1.1 and 1.2. of AI No. 03/2022 on Price Regulation of Petroleum Products and Renewable Fuels and Other Protective Measure.

Based on the above, it was decided as in the enacting clause of this Decision.

This Decision shall enter into force (1) day after publication in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Kosovo.
