The Minister of Economy, Employment, Trade, Industry, Entrepreneurship and Strategic Investments, pursuant to Articles 11 of Law No. 06/L-113 on the Organization and Functioning of the State Administration and Independent Agencies, Article 8.1.4, and items 20, 30 and 31 of Annex 7 of the Government's Regulation 05/2020 on Areas of Administrative Responsibility of the Office of the Prime Minister and Ministries, and the Government's Decisions 01/09 of 13 March 2020, 1/11 of 15 March 2020 and 01/24 of 8 April 2020 and 02/38 of 31 May 2020, as well as taking into account the decisions and instructions of the Ministry of Health, MEETIESI Ordinances 01/01 of 12 March 2020, 01/02 and 01/03 of 17 March 2020, 01/04 of 20 March 2020, 01/05 of 23 March 2020, 01/07 of 12 April 2020 and 01/08 of 18 May 2020 and the recommendation of the National Institute of Public Health aiming to fight and prevent the COVID 19 pandemics, issues this:

ORDINANCE
for the performance of the economic activities
during public health emergency

1. Are permitted to operate also:
 - 1.1. shopping malls with closed environments; and
 - 1.2. gastronomy premises, including cafeterias, bars and restaurants.
2. Not permitted:
 - 2.1. night clubs;
 - 2.2. organizing parties and weddings in wedding halls or other facilities; and
 - 2.3. other similar activities.

3. The operator responsible for the shopping mall must take these measures:
 - 3.1. make sure that there will be no crowd in common areas and at the entrances of the shopping mall or premises, by limiting the number of people that enter in the shopping mall, not allowing crowd and taking other necessary measures;
 - 3.2. disinfect common areas of the shopping mall and ensure that the operators of the premises disinfect the premises;
 - 3.3. at each entrance of the shopping mall, put a device and check people whether they have high temperature;
 - 3.4. provide hand disinfectant for the people at the entrance of the shopping mall and in sufficient points in common areas;
 - 3.5. as possible, provide gloves and masks to the people that do not have;
 - 3.6. to not allow entering in the shopping mall people with high temperatures, who do not wear gloves and masks, who disagree to disinfect their hands, or who do not obey other measures, and
 - 3.7. encourage premises inside the shopping mall to avoid cash payment, encouraging clients (through discounts or other forms) for electronic payments.
4. if there is no single operator responsible for the shopping mall, the responsibility falls jointly and separately for the operators of the premises within the shopping mall.
5. Responsible operators for the premise within the shopping mall or for the gastronomy premise must take these measures:
 - 5.1. make sure that there will be no crowd in the premise, by limiting the number of people that enter in the shopping mall, not allowing crowd and taking other necessary measures;
 - 5.2. disinfect the premise;
 - 5.3. provide hand disinfectant for the people at the entrance of the premise and in sufficient points within the premise;
 - 5.4. to not allow entering in the premise people who disagree to disinfect their hands, or who do not obey other measures, and
 - 5.5. avoid cash payment, encouraging clients (through discounts or other forms) for electronic payments.
6. Responsible operator for the shopping mall, the premise within the shopping mall or for the gastronomy premise must take all measures required by the Government's decisions,

decisions and ordinances of the responsible ministries and the recommendation of the National Institute of Public Health aiming to fight and prevent the COVID 19 pandemics.

7. Responsible operator for the gastronomy premise must take all measures required by the instruction of the ministry of Health on gastronomy.
8. Municipal inspectors in coordination with the MEETIESI inspectors with monitor the implementation of this ordinance
9. Remain in force the ordinances MEETIESI 01/01-01/05, 01/07 and 01/08, for as long as have not been modified by this ordinance or by decision of the Ministry of Health or competent authorities.
10. This ordinance enters into force immediately.
