The Minister of Economy, Employment, Trade, Industry, Entrepreneurship and Strategic Investments, pursuant to Articles 11 of Law No. 06/L-113 on the Organization and Functioning of the State Administration and Independent Agencies, Article 8.1.4, and items 20, 30 and 31 of Annex 7 of the Government's Regulation 05/2020 on Areas of Administrative Responsibility of the Office of the Prime Minister and Ministries, and the Government's Decisions 01/09 of 13 March 2020, 1/11 of 15 March 2020 and 01/24 of 8 April 2020, as well as taking into account the decisions of the Ministry of Health, MEETIESI Ordinances 01/01 of 12 March 2020, 01/02 and 01/03 of 17 March 2020, 01/04 of 20 March 2020, 01/05 of 23 March, and 01/07 of 12 April 2020 and the recommendation of the National Institute of Public Health aiming to fight and prevent the COVID 19 pandemics, issues this:

ORDINANCE
for the performance of the economic activities
During public health emergency

1. Complexes consisted of premises that have access to the open environment and are interconnected with common spaces, which include yards, bazaars and similar spaces are **permitted** to operate
2. Shopping malls that operate in a closed environment remain closed.
3. The operator responsible for the complex from point 1 must take these measures:
 - 3.1. make sure that there will be no crowd in common areas and at the entrances of the complex or premises, by limiting the number of people that enter in the complex, not allowing crowd and taking other necessary measures;
 - 3.2. disinfect common areas of the complex every two hours and ensure that the operators of the premises disinfect the premises every two hours;

- 3.3. at each entrance of the complex, put a device and check people whether they have high temperature;
 - 3.4. provide hand disinfectant for the people at the entrance of the complex and in sufficient points in common areas;
 - 3.5. as possible, provide gloves and masks to the people that do not have;
 - 3.6. to not allow entering in the complex people high temperatures, who do not wear gloves and masks, who disagree to disinfect their hands, or who do not obey other measures, and
 - 3.7. encourage premises inside the complex to avoid cash payment, encouraging clients (through discounts or other forms) for electronic payments.
4. Responsible operators for complex from point 1 and operators of premises in the complex must take all measures required by the Government's decision, decisions and ordinances of the responsible ministries as well as the recommendations of the National Institute of Public Health regarding the fight and prevention of COVID 19 pandemics.
 5. if there is no single operator responsible for the complex from point 1, the responsibility falls jointly and separately for the operators of the premises within the complex.
 6. Municipal inspectors in coordination with MEETIESI inspectors will monitor the implementation of this ordinance.
 7. Remain in force the ordinances MEETIESI 01/01-01/05 and 01/07, for as long as have not been modified by this ordinance or by decision of the Ministry of Health or the competent authorities.
 8. This ordinance enters into force immediately.
