Based on Articles 92.4 and 93 (4) of the Constitution of the Republic of Kosovo, Articles 10 and 11 of Law No. 06/L 113 on the organization and functioning of the state administration and independent agencies, Article 46 paragraphs 1 and 2 of Law No. 04/L 240 on anti-dumping and countervailing measures, as well as Article 8.1.4 and Annex 12 of Regulation (GRK) No. 02/2021 on the Areas of Administrative Responsibility of the Office of the Prime Minister and ministries, the Minister of Industry, Entrepreneurship and Trade issues the following:

DECISION

ON IMPOSING ANTI DUMPING SAFEGUARD MEASURE ON THE IMPORT OF CONCENTRATE FOR POULTRY AND ANIMALS FROM SERBIA

- 1. Imposes** the final anti-dumping safeguard measure of four eurocents (0.04€) per kilogram on the import of all types of concentrate for poultry and animals originating from Serbia included in the tariff code 2309905100.
- Any final anti-dumping or countervailing liabilities must expire after a maximum of five (5) years from its impose or five (5) years after the date of the final complete review regarding dumping, subsidizing or damages and Kosovo's interests, except in cases where the review (review of expiration) concludes that expiration or termination of these liabilities may lead to the continuation or reappearance of dumping, subsidies or damage.
- The measure from point 1 of this decision is imposed to all imports of these products from Serbia.
- This decision enters into force immediately.

Reasoning

Upon the request of local producers and the proposal of the Commission for the Assessment of Special Duties on Imports, the Department of Trade has begun investi-

gating import from Serbia and the sale in the market of the Republic of Kosovo of concentrate for poultry and animals. The investigation was conducted in accordance with the Law on Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Measures.

The Department has found that concentrate for poultry and animals originating from Serbia are sold at lower prices in the market of the Republic of Kosovo comparing to the domestic market of Serbia. This practice affects imports, by directly and increasingly harming the local producer.

Subsequently, after consulting the Commission and invoking paragraphs 1 and 2 of Article 46 of the Law, the Department has recommended the imposition of an anti-dumping safeguard measure as in the enacting clause.

Legal advice: This decision is the final act in the administrative procedure. The dissatisfied party may initiate an administrative dispute at the competent court.
