Based on Articles 92 paragraph 4 and 93 paragraph 4 of the Constitution of the Republic of Kosovo, Articles 10 and 11 of Law No. 06/L-113 on the organization and functioning of the state administration and independent agencies, Article 46 paragraphs 2 and paragraph 2 of Article 48 of Law No. 04/L-240 on anti-dumping and countervailing measures, as well as Article 8 paragraph 1 and sub-paragraph 1.4 and Annex 12 of Regulation (GRK) No. 02/2021 on the Areas of Administrative Responsibility of the Office of the Prime Minister and ministries, the Minister of Industry, Entrepreneurship and Trade issues the following:

## **DECISION**

1. On continuing with anti-dumping and countervailing measures in the amount of 0.04 euro cents for the import of flour from Serbia.

## **Reasoning**

Within the Department of Trade, respectively, the Commission for Assessment of Special Duties on Imports, which on 20.10.2022 held the meeting regarding the re-assessment analysis of anti-dumping protective measure on the flour production sector in Kosovo and the import from Serbia. Within this analysis, are compared the data on the import of flour from Serbia to the Kosovo market, which show that there is a decrease in import in the period of 2017-2022.

Prior to setting anti-dumping measure, for the import of flour from Serbia, in 2017, the import of flour was higher, while after imposing the protective measure, in 2018, the data show a decrease in the import of flour. The highest decrease in the import of flour from Serbia was recorded in 2019.

Based on these data analysed by the Department of Trade, we note that the effects of the measure are evident, as well as based on recommendation of the Commission for Assessment of Special Duties on Imports for continuing the measure.

2. This decision enters into force on the day of signing.

*Legal advice:* This decision is the final act in the administrative procedure. The dissatisfied party may initiate an administrative dispute in the competent court.
